TIMING/LENGTH OF PROGRAM

Ideally we'd love the potential Intern to start ASAP and join us for 6 months – 1 year. We have some flexibility around timing, so have a conversation with us.

EXPERINCE & QUALIFICATIONS

We make it a priority to give the potential intern an opportunity to experience and grow in every area of camp. However, depending on where your giftings lie will also depend on where camp can help develop your skills too.

You will have the opportunity to complete a Skills Active 'Introduction to Christian Camping' qualification which covers fundamentals in the camping industry.

If you do not yet have a current first aid certificate MiCamp will also cover the costs to have you complete one.

One of the most important areas we want to see our interns grow in is spiritually. MiCamp sets aside time for the Intern to complete online bible studies and will also assign the intern a mentor who will aim to have a monthly catch up to set learning goals etc.

WHAT TO EXPECT

The Internship program is not paid, rather is a volunteer program. MiCamp will provide the intern with onsite accommodation, internet, food & travel allowance along with the paying the costs for the qualifications mentioned above.

At MiCamp we treat our staff & interns fairly. Camp life is always a little bit of give and take but on average you would expect to work on average a 40 hr week. This would include study time.

HOW TO APPLY

Flick us an email and we'll send you an online application form – which will ask you questions and for references.

If successful in your application you'll be required to provide us with ID & a police vetting form.
